VAN METER, DALLAS COUNTY, Iowa –

There is a scheduled service interruption on Wednesday, July 24, 2024 from 8:00am – 1:00pm impacting the residents on Park Street, Lakeview Drive, Division Avenue, Meyer Court, and Arlington Avenue in Van Meter, Iowa.

Authorities with the City of Van Meter have issued a boil advisory for Wednesday, July 24, 2024 at 1:00pm until Monday, July 29, 2024 for customers on Park Street, Lakeview Drive, Division Avenue, Meyer Court, and Arlington Avenue due to public water infrastructure improvements.

Approximately 55 residences will be impacted.

Upon completion of the interruption, residents should boil water as a precaution. Bring all water used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth or preparing food to a boil. Boil for two minutes and cool before using. Or use bottled water. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water. Tap water can be used for bathing and similar purposes.

Public Works will collect and test two sets of water samples, taken at least 16 hours apart, to determine when the water is safe and the advisory can be lifted. The City of Van Meter will notify residents when the boil order is lifted. Notification will be on the City's website, Facebook page, and posted at City Hall, the Van Meter Public Library, the Van Meter Post Office and Casey's General Store.
