East Street Underpass

The City is currently working on designing, bidding, and construction phase engineering services for the pedestrian underpass that connects the Van Meter school with the athletic fields on the east side of East Street. The precast concrete box culvert underpass was constructed in 2014, and since then, the City has patched the roadway near and over the culvert multiple times to mitigate the "dip" in the road resulting from settlement. The plan is to remove the asphalt pavement over the culvert and excavate the backfill adjacent to the bottom of the floor slab. The road will be closed during construction, and traffic will be detoured. The existing guardrail will be removed and reinstalled. We will continue to provide an updated timeline as we become aware of them.

What is TIF?

- TIF stands for tax increment finance.
- Iowa cities and counties may establish TIF districts.
- A "base" valuation of the property value is established when a TIF district is created.
- Van Meter benefits from TIF projects. TIF brings jobs and development, growing income, and sales tax revenues for the city.
- TIF enables public-private partnerships, closing the financing gap on bringing developments to Van Meter.
