

Online Bill Pay



The City of Van Meter is excited to announce that we are switching our utility billing software from gWorks to Caselle.

Caselle is a more user-friendly option for City staff and the citizens of Van Meter. The new software will make the utility billing process faster, make online payments easier, and give the option for building permits, recreation fees, and more to be made online.

Through the new portal, payments can be made as a guest user or users may create an account. You are also able to set up ACH payments through City Hall.

For ACH payments to be made through City Hall, the account holder will need to fill out the ACH Authorization Agreement form and provide a voided check.



These changes are only applicable to those who had online autopay set up through FrontDesk. Payments can also be made in person at City Hall as well or mailed to PO Box 160 in Van Meter, IA, 50261.

Each honor represents a veteran receiving The Final Salute, a solemn tribute that includes a three-round volley. - January 1, 2025 June 30, 2025: 103 volleys performed
- July 1, 2025 November 21, 2025: 112 volleys performed

Community Food Pantry

We are pleased to share that a food pantry has been temporarily located at City Hall. It is open to anyone in need. This initiative is made possible thanks to the generosity of some remarkable donors. SNOW REMOVAL: No person shall park or allow a vehicle to remain parked on a public street in the City from the time it begins to snow until such time as the streets have been cleared of accumulated snow from curb to curb (or from all of the traveled portion of the roadway for those streets which do not have curbs) or 48 hours, whichever time is shorter. Vehicles shall be removed immediately once it begins to snow. The Director of Public Works and Utilities is also empowered to end the prohibition on parking prior to the expiration of the 48-hour period if the Director determines that the streets have been cleared. The Director of Public Works and Utilities shall notify the Police Chief when the parking prohibition has ended.

DUMPING OF SNOW: It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, place, or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley so as to obstruct gutters, or impeded the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition therein; except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley temporarily, such accumulation shall be removed promptly by the property owner or agent. Arrangements for the prompt removal of such accumulations shall be made prior to moving the snow.





REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within 48-hours after such accumulations, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax.
