## Parks & Recreation Board Vacancy

As of November 25, 2024, there is a vacancy on the Van Meter Parks & Recreation Board. The term for the vacated seat will be from the date of appointment through June 30, 2029. The Van Meter Park Board is a group of volunteers committed to the beautification and enhancement of the community. The Park Board also sponsor a variety of community events. The Park Board typically meets at 6:00pm on the 1st Thursday of each month at City Hall.

## **Master Trails Update**

The City and Parks & Rec are excited to be able to share some updates on the Master Trails Project! This is a phased project so the updates only pertain to Phase 1. Phase 1 will be a 10' wide concrete multipurpose trail from 360th Street (F90) in the western City Right of Way North to where the School walking trail currently exists. engaged Bolton & City Menk preliminary trail study in 2021 and through the grant funding from CIRTPA and the Dallas County Foundation, preliminary work turned into design, planning & specifications! Survey work has already started! We look forward to being to provide regular updates and will be partnering with Bolton & Menk to hold an informational community meeting in the Spring!

## **Snow Reminders**

SNOW REMOVAL. No person shall park or allow a vehicle to remain parked on a public street in the City from the time it begins to snow until such time as the streets have been cleared of accumulated snow from curb to curb (or from all of the traveled portion of the roadway for those streets which do not have curbs) or 48 hours, whichever time is shorter. Vehicles shall be removed immediately once it begins to snow. The Director of Public Works and Utilities is also empowered to end the prohibition on parking prior to the expiration of the 48-hour period if the Director determines that the streets have been cleared. The Director of Public Works and Utilities shall notify the Police Chief when the parking prohibition has ended.

DUMPING OF SNOW. It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, place, or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley so as to obstruct gutters, or impeded the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition therein; except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley temporarily, such accumulation shall be removed promptly by the property owner or agent. Arrangements for the prompt removal of such accumulations shall be made prior to moving the snow.

REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS. It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within 48-hours after such accumulations, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax.

### How to Create a Public User Account in the new Utility Portal

Step 1: Go to <a href="https://vanmeteria.frontdeskgworks.com/">https://vanmeteria.frontdeskgworks.com/</a> and click "Create New"

**Step 2:** Select **YES** to "Are you already receiving utility bills from us?"

**Step 3:** Enter your account number & utility service address

**Step 4:** Confirm your account number & utility service address


**Step 5:** Enter your name, email address, cell phone & set password


