

Public Hearing - FY25 Budget Amendment #2

 Planning & Zoning Workshop presented by lowa State Extension







Construction started in May 2025. It is estimated to be completed in late Summer of 2025. The end goal is the improvement of Arlington Ave through resurfacing of the street, replacement of curbs and gutters, installation of stormwater, and replacement of intakes. This project was funded through revenue generated by the State of Iowa's Road Use Tax fund as allocated to the City of Van Meter and the Series 2021 bond proceeds. Arlington Ave is currently closed with limited availability to sidewalks as well.

#### Water Main Replacement Phase 1

Phase one of the water main project began in April of 2025. The estimated completion date is in Fall of 2025. This project includes installation of over three thousand (3,000) linear feet of 8-inch water main along Van Buren Drive, Hazel Street, De Soto Road, Feller Curve and a small portion of Arlington Avenue. This project is funded by Series 2021 bond proceeds. The installation includes directional boring and open cut, hydrants, valves, water service line transfers, surface restoration, seeding, removal of existing hydrants, abandonment of existing water main, surface, restoration, seeding and miscellaneous associated work, including cleanup. There are no planned complete road closures at this time. The plans include temporary closures of one lane of traffic at a time.

## **Employee Spotlight**

Police Officer Andrew Cooper has been proudly serving our community since March of 2023. He is dedicated to protecting and serving our small town. You may have also noticed Officer Cooper driving around in a new police vehicle. It was time for an upgrade, with the old Ford Explorer being retired to the Van Meter Fire Department for use as an EMS Response Vehicle, and the Police Department was very excited about the opportunity to acquire a 2024

F-150 for the Department! Officer Cooper spends a lot of his time on duty patrolling, but he also is responsible for much more including paperwork & report writing, following up with court hearings, and more. He dedicates a lot of his time to serving the City, including sacrificing many weekends, holidays, and his nights to patrol our town and keep us safe. In addition to his work for the Police Department, he is also a member of the Van Meter Volunteer Fire Department. He was also the mastermind behind bringing National Night Out to Van Meter. Be sure to keep an eye out for this year's event on Tuesday, August 5, 2025. Thank you Officer Cooper for all that you do for our City and all that you contribute to the police department! We truly appreciate you and all that you do.

#### Street Use and Maintenance Reminders

Chapter 135 - Street Use & Maintenance of the Van Meter Code of Ordinances determines street use and maintenance.

The following are reminders from this code:

- It is unlawful to throw or deposit any glass, nails, tacks, trash, leaves, grass or anything else that may be washed into the storm sewer or injure another person, animal, or vehicle.
- It is unlawful to drive on any street or alley that is temporarily closed or barricaded.
- Burning on a street, in the city right-of-way, or in the alley is prohibited.
- Property owners are responsible for maintaining the city right-of-way abutting their property.



#### Solicitor and Peddler's Permits

Reminder - any solicitors or peddlers are required to have an approved permit issued by the City of Van Meter before going door-to-door within city limits. You are allowed to ask them to show their permit or call City Hall to check if there is an issued permit.

#### Weeds and Brush

Dense growth of all weeds, vines, brush or other vegetation in the City can constitute a health, safety, or fire hazard. Unless a variance is allowed by resolution of the Council pursuant to Section 53.06, weeds, brush, or other uncultivated plants, except trees, shall be cut, mowed, and maintained so as to not exceed the heights set forth specifically in this chapter. Once the vegetation has reached the height of 10 inches to 24 inches, the City will arrange to mow the property at the property owner's expense. Property used and taxed as agricultural is exempt from this chapter's height and mowing requirements.




