### **NEWS FROM CITY HALL**

At the February 12, 2024 regular City Council Meeting, City Staff discussed increased administrative costs regarding the processing of utility bills. The City pays over \$1000 a month in fixed administrative costs relating to utility billing, postage, electronic payment processing fees and bank fees. The City Council approved the addition of a \$1.00 administrative fee to be added to each active utility account. Currently the City has just over 600 active utility accounts. Please note that this fee is in place to offset the administrative costs out of the City's general fund. This fee is not related to any funds regarding Capital Improvements or water & sewer infrastructure improvements.
