


- 1) The Van Meter City Council met for a special council meeting on Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at City Hall. Mayor Allan Adams called the meeting to order at 5:30PM. The following council members were present upon roll call: Travis Brott, Lyn Lyon, Adam Coyle, Joe Herman, and Steve Meyer.

- 2) Mayor Adams asked for an approval of the agenda as published  
Coyle moved, supported by Herman, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously
- 3) Mayor Adams opened discussion regarding the Dallas County owned maintenance shed located at 710 Pleasant Street in the City.  
Discussion ensued regarding the property and the potential for City use of the facility as-is. Further discussion ensued regarding the potential for another low-to-moderate income housing project on the property.  
Meyer moved, supported by Herma, to submit a bid packet to Dallas County for a price not to exceed \$16,500 for the property.
