

Yard waste is collected in <u>compost</u> <u>bags</u>ONLY on Thursdays through the end of November



<u>SECOND REMINDER</u>: It is illegal to discharge grass clippings and yard waste into public streets while mowing. Grass clippings in the street ultimately end up in a storm drain were they can build up and cause drainage issues and localized flooding.



<u>135.03 PLACING DEBRIS ON</u>. It is unlawful for any person to throw or deposit on any street or alley any glass, glass bottle, nails, tacks, wire, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal, leaves, grass or any other debris likely to be washed into the storm sewer and clog the storm sewer, or any substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.369)

For safety and efficiency reasons, please place your Waste Connections of Iowa cart <u>out the night before your service day or no later than 6AM on your</u> <u>service day</u>. If your service is missed, **CALL WASTE CONNECTIONS DIRECTLY**. The driver will return for your cart the same day **if** he is still in town. You should not rely on city staff to prioritize this or make the call on your behalf.

Waste Connection drivers are unable to empty carts that are overfilled with items. The lid **must** close. You are allowed one extra trash bag at no charge. Extra bag tags are sold at city hall for \$1.

Bulk waste can also be discarded with a \$5 tag which are sold at city hall. Please remove your Waste Connections containers from the street as soon after collection as possible.



- Bag all trash before placing in the container
- Place carts 3 feet apart
- Carts must be at least 6 feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences
- Cart wheels should be as close to the curb as possible
- Cart lids must be **CLOSED COMPLETELY** at all times
