Dear Jessica:

Attached please find proceedings covering the adoption of an ordinance deleting property from the TIF District for the Van Meter Urban Renewal Area. We have prepared the proceedings providing for the adoption of the ordinance on the presumption that the Council will waive the statutory requirement that an ordinance be considered at two meetings prior to the meeting at which it is finally adopted. This waiver requires the affirmative vote of not less than four of the five Council Members. If the Council does not choose to follow this procedure, we will provide substitute proceedings covering the separate considerations of the ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO.2024-11

An Ordinance Deleting Property From the Tax Increment Financing District for the Van Meter Urban Renewal Area of the City of Van Meter, Iowa, Pursuant to Section 403.19 of the Code of Iowa

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Van Meter, lowa (the "City") previously enacted Ordinance No. 94 and Ordinance No. 166 providing for the division of taxes levied on taxable property in the Van Meter Urban Renewal Area pursuant to Section 403.19 of the Code of lowa; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 94 and Ordinance No. 166, a portion of the Van Meter Urban Renewal Area in the City of Van Meter was designated a "tax increment district"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to decrease the size of the "tax increment district" by deleting certain property;

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Van Meter, Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to delete certain property from the tax increment financing district for the Van Meter Urban Renewal Area.

Section 2. Definitions. For use within this ordinance the following terms shall have the following meanings:

"Deleted Property" shall mean certain real property more particularly described, as follows:

Certain real property situated in the City of Van Meter, Dallas County, State of lowa, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of the railroad right-of way located in the South 1/2 of Section 22-78-27 as found on page 19 of 87 in an annexation document recorded in the Dallas County Recorder's office in Book 2022 Page 13373;

AND

Part of Parcel C of the N1/2 of Section 27, Township 78 N, Range 27 W of the 5th Principal Meridian except Parcel D as found on page 16 of 87 (5th Paragraph) in an annexation document recorded in the Dallas County Recorder's office in Book 2022 Page 13373;

AND

Part of Parcel C of the South1/2 of Section 22, Township 78 N, Range 27 W of the 5th Principal Meridian except Parcel D as found on page 16 of 87

(7th Paragraph) in an annexation document recorded in the Dallas County Recorder's office in Book 2022 Page 13373;

AND

Lots "A" and "B", Trails End Plat 1, City of Van Meter, Dallas County, Iowa;

AND

Parcel 21-86, Official Parcel Recorded in Book 2021, Page 30893 at the Dallas County Recorder's Office, of the SW1/4 NE1/4 and NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 28, Township 78 North, Range 27 West of the 5th PM, City of Van Meter, Dallas County, Iowa.

Section 3. The Deleted Property is hereby removed from the tax increment financing district for the Van Meter Urban Renewal Area. No division of property tax revenues as provided under Section 403.19 of the Code of lowa shall be done with respect to the Deleted Property without further action by the City Council.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Saving Clause. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
