- ✓ The signature minimum requirements for this election: 10 for City Council ---- 29 for School Board
- ✓ The Dallas County Auditor's office will serve as the filing officer for receiving nomination papers for elective city offices in the upcoming City Election. Please advise candidate's to submit paperwork to the Dallas County Auditor's office located at 210 N 10<sup>th</sup> St. Adel IA 50003

#### What is a Hotel/Motel Tax?

A city may impose a hotel/motel tax at a rate not to exceed 7 percent after a successful election of a simple majority vote within the city. The hotel/motel tax is imposed on the gross receipts from rented sleeping rooms, apartments or sleeping quarters in any hotel, motel, inn, public lodging house, rooming house, tourist court, bed-and-breakfast, shortterm rental or in any place where sleeping accommodations are The actual amount collected is furnished to transient guests. distributed to the city monthly by the Iowa Department of Revenue & at least 50% of the revenue must be utilized for Parks & Recreation improvements, programming, etc. While Van Meter does not have any hotels or motels nor are there any future plans for either, there have been a handful of short-term rentals that exist within city limits. The proposed hotel/motel tax DOES NOT impact property tax rates and will NOT impact tax rates for the residents of Van Meter.

## **News from Public Works**

The strip of land between the street and sidewalk is called the public right of way and is technically City property. This area may contain water, sewer, gas, and other utilities below the surface. It is important to maintain easy access to these utilities and to keep it clear of visual clutter that can distract drivers or hinder those using sidewalks. Property owners are still required to maintain this area of land, and it is important to keep it free of signs and other encumbrances. Dense growth of all weeks, vines, brush, or other vegetation in the City can constitute a health, safety, or fire hazard. Brush piles should not be placed in the City Right of Way. No burning of brush/leaves/weeds is allowed on any sidewalk, any area between the street and the sidewalk, any area between the street and where the sidewalk would be, culverts, or the street.

City Hall has been receiving a lot of questions regarding bill pay recently. Bill pay is when you set up an automatic payment to be withdrawn from your bank account for your bills. Often times, this automatic payment is sent as a check through the mail. Depending on when the bank sends the check, City Hall may not receive the check prior to the due date of the utility bills. This can result in late fees or disconnect notices being sent out. If you have been experiencing issues with your bill pay, you can request for your bank to send the payment earlier or you may sign up for an online account through our Front Desk portal. ## Online Bill Pay

The City's original online portal was disabled in late 2024 and was replaced with a new utility account portal. The user access information did not carry over from portal to portal.

If you previously had online access or you would like to set up online access, the steps below detail how to create a user account in the new portal. Account holders are NOT required to set up online access. Please contact info@vanmeteria.gov with questions.

#### How to Create a Public User Account in the new Utility Portal

Step 1: Go to <a href="https://vanmeteria.frontdeskgworks.com/">https://vanmeteria.frontdeskgworks.com/</a> and click "Create New"

**Step 2:** Select **YES** to "Are you already receiving utility bills from us?"

**Step 3:** Enter your account number & utility service address

**Step 4:** Confirm your account number & utility service address

**Step 5:** Enter your name, email address, cell phone & set password

You must check  $\sqrt{}$  the acknowledgement box to proceed.

Step 6: Select "Create Account"

**Step 7:** After clicking "Create Account", you will receive an email from FrontDesk to confirm your email. Upon confirmation, you can log in.

The confirmation email does time out within 30 minutes.
